

Let's All Save More Water

The Fountains Board of Directors and landscaping committee are implementing our plans to renovate our landscaping, with the primary objective of substantially reducing water usage. The first phase of this water saving project began November 26 and is scheduled to complete by January 30. There will be a substantial removal of turf and shrubs along the parkway on Atherton Street, which will then be replaced with drought tolerant plants and other materials. This area was selected due to our ability to receive reimbursement from the City of Long Beach that pays for a large percentage of the work.

Looks like we did this just in time. A stage 1 water supply shortage was recently announced for Long Beach. That means that we are allowed to water landscaping only two days a week: Mondays and Thursdays. This is in effect until the end of March, according to the Long Beach Water Department.
