½ lb. grated sharp cheddar cheese -
½ lb. grated Monterey Jack Cheese
2-7 oz. cans whole green chilies
1 cup half n half
2 eggs
¼ cup flour
1 8 oz. can tomato sauce

1. Mix Cheese together and set aside
½ cup of cheese
2. Combine half n half, eggs and
flour. Heat until smooth.
3. Split chilies and rinse out
seeds. Drain on paper towel.

4. Alternate layers of chilies, cheese,
and flour mixture.
5. Pour tomato sauce over all.
6. Top with remaining cheese
7. Bake 1 hour at 350 degrees.
